This catalogue lists seeds that have been collected by members of the congregation and also seeds from free packets that have come with gardening magazines. These packets have been split to give several people a chance to try growing them.

Remember that the pollinating insects, the bees, wasps, flies, butterflies, moths, and beetles, are facing major population declines and are essential for our food production. Many of the flowers listed here are easy to grow and will attract pollinators. Cornflowers, for example, are easy to grow, good at attracting pollinators and are a great flower for children to include in their first garden.

All the packets are free, and if you have grown too many plants, they can be kept for the St John's Plant Sale. **Please also tell your friends and family about what's on offer.**

I will leave the seeds you've requested in an envelope with your name on at the back of the church for you to pick up. They will be available from February.
